A good deal of testing and modeling of rammed earth walls has been done around the world, and the available data is usually sufficient to justify the use of rammed earth as a load-bearing wall for one- and two-story structures.

Rammed earth walls are built in panels of approximately 11.5 ft. in length with flexible joints. The material is a mix of 20% to 30% clay, sand, and 5% to 10% cement for strength and durability. In cold, wet climates, a silicate-based waterproofing agent is often added to the mix.

Rammed earth is a form of unbaked earthen construction used primarily to build walls. Other applications include floors, roofs and foundations. Recently it has also been used for furniture, garden ornaments and other features. Rammed earth is formed by compacting moist sub-soil inside temporary formwork (Figures 1 and 2).

David Easton, a rammed earth architect in California, has adapted rammed earth construction into a technique he calls PISE. It's an acronym for pneumatically impacted stabilized earth. Instead of building two-sided forms and ramming earth into them, Easton takes a pressure hose and sprays the earthen mixture against a one-sided form.

When finished, rammed earth is about as strong as concrete. Houses built of rammed earth have several advantages over wood-frame construction. The walls are fireproof, rot resistant, and impervious to termites. The solid, 18-24 in (45.72-60.96 cm) thick walls are nearly soundproof.
