Receipt of a follow-up visit within 30 days of discharge was associated with a slightly lower adjusted odds ratio (AOR) of hospital readmission during days 31-120 postdischarge (schizophrenia, AOR=.88, 95% confidence interval [CI]=.81-.96; bipolar disorder, AOR=.91, CI=.85-.98).
